

## COVID -19 EXTENSION OF MASSACHUSETTS EVICTION MORATORIUM July 21, 2020

On July 21, 2020, Governor Charlie Baker issued a further Order extending the Massachusetts Eviction Moratorium, known as "An Act Providing for a Moratorium on Evictions and Foreclosures During the COVID-19 Emergency" (the "Act") for an additional sixty (60) days. In basic terms, this means that, through October 17, 2020, owners may not serve notices to quit, demands to vacate, or commence any eviction cases for "non-essential evictions" which include non-payment of rent, failure to vacate at the conclusion of a tenancy, or material lease violations which do not involve allegations of criminal activity or conduct which directly impacts health and safety.
